



SPORTS FIELD USE SURVEY | JULY 2012

A Sports Field Use Survey was conducted by the Union City Leisure Services in the summer 2012 to compare field rental fees and information with surrounding cities. The survey asks how much each agency charged for sports field use (ie. 60'/ 90' baseball diamonds, open grass areas, artificial turf). Twelve (12) cities covering the greater East Bay and one (1) from the South Bay participated in the survey.
